Bear Valley Electric Service, Inc. ("BVES") hereby transmits for filing the following:

**SUBJECT:** Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program Balancing Account

#### **SUPPLEMENT**

BVES is supplementing its Advice Letter ("AL") No. 431-E. BVES received notice from Energy Division ("ED") requesting BVES to correct typographical errors in its Advice Letter found in the program's name. BVES inadvertently erroneously named the program "Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resilien<u>ce</u> Rebuild Program".

The correct name as adopted in Decision No. ("D.") 21-11-002 is "Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program" BVES hereby correct all instances of this typo error. This supplemental filing replaces Advice Letter No. 431-E in its entirety.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On November 4, 2021, the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission" or "CPUC") issued D.21-11-002 adopting the Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild ("WNDRR") Program.

#### D.21-11-002 OP 2(c) states:

(c) The WNDRR Program shall be funded with a single payment made by each participating IOU within 60 days after the advice letter establishing the necessary balancing account is effective, in the amount stated in Appendix B, and each IOU shall recover the amount of its payment from the IOUs' residential customers through non-bypassable Public Purpose Program (PPP) charges amortized over one year.

#### D.21-11-002 OP 2(g) states:

(g) Each IOU, except SCE, shall submit a Tier 1 Advice Letter within 30 days from the issuance of this decision to establish a WNDRR Program balancing account to record its (1) payment to SCE to fund the WNDRR Program and (2) recovery of that payment from residential customers over one year via non-bypassable PPP charges.

BVES's contribution to the program is \$133,060.1

#### WNDRR BALANCING ACCOUNT

BVES hereby establishes its Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program Balancing Account. The purpose of this balancing account is to track payment issued by BVES to fund the WNDRR Program and any revenue received for recovery of that payment from BVES's residential customers.

See accompanying tariff "Preliminary Statement YY".

#### TIER DESIGNATION

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

BVES respectfully requests this advice letter becomes effective on November 4, 2021.

#### NOTICE AND PROTESTS

A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter. A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the CPUC in acting on the request.

A protest must be mailed within 20 days of the date the CPUC accepts the advice letter for filing. The Calendar is available on the CPUC's website at <a href="https://www.cpuc.ca.gov">www.cpuc.ca.gov</a>.

A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter.

The utility must respond to a protest within five days.

#### A. Purpose

The purpose of the Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild Program Balancing Account ("WNDRRBA") is to track payments issued for BVES's participation in the Wildfire and Natural Disaster Resiliency Rebuild ("WNDRR") program, and track recovery of these payments. This balancing account is established in accordance with Decision No. 21-11-002. This account will expire in one year unless otherwise directed by the Commission.

#### B. Procedure

The Utility shall:

- 1. Record expenses issued by BVES for BVES contribution to the WNDRR program.
- 2. Record revenues received from the WNDRR portion of the Public Purpose Program surcharge collected from residential customers over one year via non-bypassable PPP charges.
- 3. Record monthly interest. Monthly interest will accrue at 1/12 of the interest rate on 3-month Commercial Paper for the previous month, as published in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15 or its successor publication.

#### C. Recovery

Decision No. 21-11-002 set BVES's WNDRR program contribution at \$133,060. The Decision authorizes BVES recover its contribution in rates from residential customers through nonbypassable Public Purpose Program (PPP) charges amortized over one year. BVES will recover its contribution from its residential customers only.
