Bear Valley Electric Service, Inc. ("BVES") hereby transmits for filing the following:

SUBJECT: Small Business California Climate Credit Distribution Modifications

PURPOSE:

Pursuant to Resolution No. E-5339, BVES is required to provide a list of eligibility changes, via a Tier 1 advice letter. This advice letter complies with Resolution No. E-5339, Ordering Paragraph No. ("OP") 5.

BACKGROUND:

In D.21-08-026, the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") ordered BVES to implement the California Climate Credit for residential and commercial customers. In Resolution No. E-5339, approved on August 22, 2024, the Commission ordered that recipients with 100 or more eligible accounts under the existing usage criteria are no longer eligible to receive the Small Business California Climate Credit. Specifically, OP5 states:

5. IOUs are directed to reassess eligibility at minimum at the start of each California Air Resources Board (CARB) Cap-and-Trade Program compliance period. IOUs may choose to reexamine eligibility more often if they desire. IOUs must provide a list of any eligibility changes to Energy Division resulting from an eligibility review via a Tier 1 Advice Letter within 60 days of a change in eligibility.

LIST OF ELIGIBILITY CHANGES

• Charter/Spectrum

On September 16, 2024, BVES notified Charter/Spectrum that it no longer qualified to receive Small Business California Climate Credit, because recipients with 100 or more eligible accounts under the existing usage criteria are no longer eligible to receive the credit on any account. Charter/Spectrum did not object to BVES's letter or its actions.

TIER DESIGNATION

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

BVES respectfully requests this advice letter become effective on September 16, 2024.

NOTICE AND PROTESTS

A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter. A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the CPUC in acting on the request.

A protest must be sent within 20 days of the date the CPUC accepts the advice letter for filing. The Calendar is available on the CPUC's website at <u>www.cpuc.ca.gov</u>.

A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter.

The utility must respond to a protest within five days.
