Advice Letter No. 501-E

California Public Utilities Commission

Bear Valley Electric Service, Inc. ("BVES") hereby transmits for filing the following:

SUBJECT: <u>Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account User Fees, effective January 1, 2025.</u>

BACKGROUND

The California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") uses Public Utilities Code §431 as the basis for its methodology to annually assess user fees for energy, water, sewer, and telecommunication utilities.

Public Utilities Code §431 states,

"The commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers and subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421). The annual fee shall be established to produce a total amount equal to that amount established in the authorized Commission budget for the same year, including adjustments for increases in employee compensation, other increases appropriated by the Legislature, and an appropriate reserve to regulate public utilities less the amount to be paid from special accounts or funds pursuant to section 402, reimbursements, federal funds, and any other revenues, and the amount of unencumbered funds from the preceding year."

The California Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account Fee, as shown in BVES's Schedule No. UF-E, is part of the "Taxes and Fees" surcharge shown on customers' bills. This total is the sum of the California Energy Commission ("CEC") electric energy surcharge rate and the surcharge noted in Schedule UF-E, adopted by the CPUC.

RESOLUTION NO. M-4874

Per CPUC Resolution No. M-4874, in which it set forth the levels of the Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account Fee ("PUCURA") effective January 1,

2025, BVES is modifying its Schedule No. UF-E from the current rate of \$0.001/kWh to \$0.0008/kWh.

Resolution No. M-4874 was adopted at the December 19, 2024 CPUC meeting.

Effective January 1, 2025, the user fee shall be \$0.0008/kWh. As a result, all BVES rate schedules and customer' bills will show the line item "Taxes and Fees" at a rate of \$0.001100/kWh, a decrease from the current rate of \$0.00130/kWh.

Note: On December 2024, BVES was informed that the current CEC electrical energy surcharge, which is not impacted by Resolution No. M-4874, will remain the same for 2025.

A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter.

The utility must respond to a protest within five days.
